

Stateline Friends Weaving Retreat -2017

We are very excited about the 12th Stateline Friends Weaving Retreat.

General Information:

Our Retreat runs Thursday through Saturday.

Our Retreat is intended for adults over 18. If youth under 18 wish to participate they must be accompanied by a registered adult.

Our event is held at the Kuhlman Building which is located on the Wayne County Fairgrounds 861 Salisbury Road North, Richmond, IN 47374.

All participants should bring their usual basket making tools and any special tools listed for their classes.

Online Registration

Registration Fee

Registration Fee for the 3 day Retreat is **\$45.00**. There is no membership fee to attend the Stateline Friends Weaving Registration will close at midnight 12/01/2016 OR when 325 registrations for classes have been received, whichever comes first. You will be placed on a waiting list if you register after the maximum has been reached.

Retreat. There will be a \$10.00 late fee for registrations received after the December 1, 2016 deadline.

Class fees will be due by January 1, 2017.

Special Note: Please remember that we do not pay the teachers a teaching fee or travel pay, so you may see these same classes offered at other events for varying prices. We try to keep our registration fee low to help offset this price difference.

We are sorry, but after February 28, 2017, NO refunds of registration and/or late registration fees, class fees or camping fees will be made for ANY reason. You will be responsible to make arrangements with the teacher to get your kit, or to have your kit picked up by someone, or you can sell your class to someone else who is already registered to attend. The teacher(s) nor the Stateline Friends Weaving Retreat Committee are responsible to pick up your kit(s) or send it/them to you in the event you cannot attend. You must make your own arrangements to obtain these. The teachers need to have their final count in to them in order to purchase materials for their classes according to their numbers, cut kits and to determine their income and expenses ahead of time. This is a business for them, so although we would like to accommodate you, we must be firm in this decision. Thank you for your cooperation.

Cancellations prior to March 1, 2017, you will receive your refund minus a \$10.00 processing fee.

There will be a \$35 fee on any check that is returned for insufficient funds.

Food

We will provide to all participants at no additional charge: Thursday, Friday and Saturday a continental breakfast and lunch. Dinner will be on your own, there are many great restaurants in the area. Breakfast will consist of bagels, fruit, milk, juice, coffee, etc. Lunch may consist of chicken, meat, vegetables, potatoes, dessert etc.

Snacks of chips, cookies, fruit and vegetables, etc will be available all day. We will also have soda pop, water, tea, coffee, etc. to drink.

We do ask that each participant bring a sweet snack, a salty snack, fruit or raw vegetables to share. This donation will help us to continue to keep the cost of our Retreat down. There will also be a donation box located in the kitchen, you are not obligated to contribute but any and all donations will be appreciated. Any excess food, snacks, etc will be donated to local food banks, nursing homes, churches, etc. If you bring a homemade snack, please consider bringing copies of the recipe to share.

Accommodations

Camper hookups are available on the Kuhlman Building grounds for \$20.00 per night. This fee must be prepaid with your class fees.

Participants will need to make their own lodging accommodations.

Many Hotels/Motels and Bed & Breakfasts are within 4-7 miles of the Kuhlman Building.
